iREADY- Diagnostics (3x per year) Progress Monitoring (every 4 weeks at minimum). Data is analyzed and used to look at student growth in comparison with grade level standards. Gaps are addressed using response to intervention.

SRCL Grant: Provides training and guidance to teach all students with Tier 1 Curriculum.

Title 1 Tutors: Provide tutoring and enrichment embedded in the school day for students who have educational gaps. Work and collaborate with core teachers in an effort to support instruction of high level curriculum and state standards.

Journeys to Careers is offered as an elective to 8th grade students.

RTI is implemented school wide. Teachers monitor students carefully and address all tiered students within the classroom using DI and small group instruction.

Title 1 funding is used to provide tutors to assist in Tler II & III interventions. Data is analyzed frequently in an effort to provide necessary support and assistance to struggling students. Both in academics and behavior.

Weekly PLCs with a plan in place to use data to monitor student progress and instruction. Family Involvement Committee: scheduled literacy and numeracy nights, student led data talks with their parents and teachers.
